1. Relationship with God

2. Husband-Wife

3. Dependent Children

4. Service to God (*Ministry*)/Work

5. Adult Children (*except when in crisis*)/Extended Family/Friends

Biblical Priorities

Consider placing the Biblical Priorities in a prominent place in your home
(kitchen fridge, mirror, desk)

Why is it important to have my priorities in line?

When one of the lower-priority areas is negatively impacting a higher-priority area, something is out of order.

Examples: Ministry is negatively impacting my relationship with God, my spouse, or my children. Or, prioritizing ministry or work before prioritizing my relationship with God

Priorities Questions

Take time to sit down and answer the following questions:

- Do you believe this is how God wants you to order your life?
 - How do you actually live out this order?
- At what times in your married life have you lived in a state of Godly priorities?
- What happens on a weekly basis that gets first place, second place, etc?
- Do you have a substitute favourite activity that replaces time with God?
What is it?
- Does the practical everyday schedule of your life and work interfere with maintaining a godly priority structure? Why or how?
- Is there a need to adjust or change? What do you need to do differently?
 - What is the most significant factor that enables you or interferes with keeping your daily life in order of priorities?

In bullet format, write down the flow of order you envision for an ideal day when it is directed by Godly priorities.
